## **Selection procedures for 2020 Youth Tour Contest**

**Sponsored by Nobles Cooperative Electric, Worthington, MN**

- Awards:**
1. 1st Place: Washington Youth Tour
  2. 2nd Place: First alternate and \$150
  3. 3rd Place: Second alternate and \$100
  4. \$500 Scholarship winner
  5. First 15 applicants receive a \$20 gift certificate to Amazon.com.

**Eligibility:**

The contest is open to any current high school freshmen, sophomores, juniors or seniors attending school in Nobles' service area. Visit the website: <http://youthtour.coop> or <http://www.mrea.org/youth-tour/>.

**Contest:**

1. Contestant writes a 300-word essay (no more than two pages double-spaced) or a 3-4 minute video on a topic determined by the cooperative. This year's topic: "We've grown accustomed to having electricity on demand in the world we live in such as clicking a remote control to turn on a TV, using a computer, playing video games, or charging our cell phones. Describe the impact on your life and community in a world without electricity."
2. Complete the attached application.
3. Submit completed essay and application form by **February 28, 2020** to:

- **Tour the monuments:** Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, Franklin Delano Roosevelt memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Korean Veterans Memorial, Arlington Cemetery, etc...
- **Tour historic sights:** Washington National Cathedral, Supreme Court, Library of Congress, Smithsonian Museums, Holocaust Memorial Museum, FBI Headquarters Tour, Mount Vernon, etc.
